# **Jeep Wrangler JK Inner Fenders**

#### Removing the Stock Inner Fenders-

- 1) Locate the three 3/8" screws holding the stock plastic inner fenders in place
- 2) Remove the 3/8" screws and set them to the side. These will be used later in the installation You Will Need:

### A ratchet, wrench, or impact

- 3/8" wrench or socket
- 3) Remove the stock inner fender

#### **Installing the New Inner Fenders-**

- 1) Set the new inner fender in place and ensure that the existing holes in the new inner fender align with the holes from the stock inner fender
- 2) Insert the three stock 3/8" screws from steps 1&2 back into their respective places in such a way as to secure the new inner fender to the vehicle
- 3) Tighten the three screws to secure the new inner fenders to the vehicle
- 4) Locate the parts of the new inner fender that lay over the body mount and that lays over part of the body close to the front door
- 5) Using the provided speed screws, secure the new inner fender to the vehicle

#### You Will Need:

- An impact driver or drill
- 3/8" socket
- 6) Repeat for installing the passenger side inner fender
